



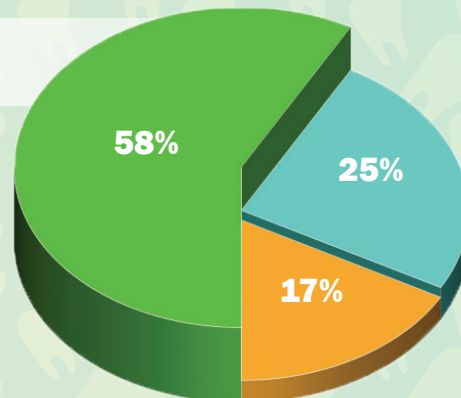
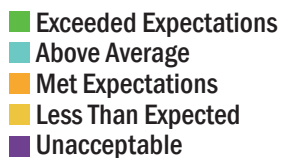
## 2016 Brush “I Need My Teeth” Assembly Evaluation



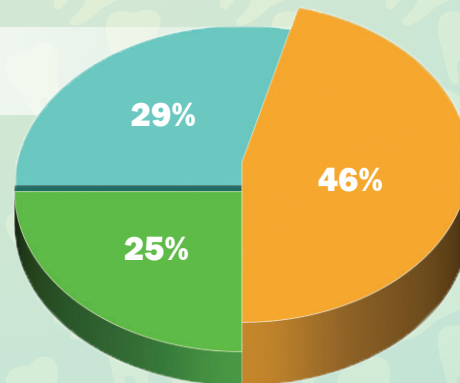
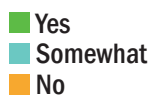
An electronic survey was sent to the teachers who scheduled the Brush “I Need My Teeth” assembly. Thirty-one performances were presented to schools in Michigan and Indiana, grades Pre-K through 5th grade. The assembly was presented to 6,097 attendees.

Results were overwhelmingly positive, with 83% of teachers indicating the assembly was above average or exceeded expectations. Forty-six percent of the teachers surveyed did not teach oral health in any way in their classrooms, while another 29% indicated they teach about oral health “somewhat.”

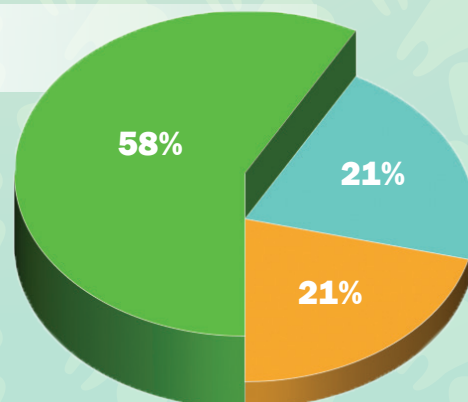
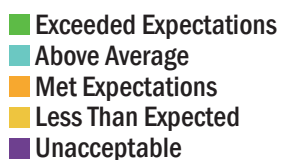
### How was your overall experience with the Brush assembly?
