



2018 Brush "I Need My Teeth" Assembly Evaluation

An electronic survey was sent to the teachers who scheduled the Brush "I Need My Teeth" assembly. Twenty-five performances were presented to schools in Michigan, Ohio, and Indiana, grades Pre-K through 5th grade. The assembly was presented to **4,085 students and 284 teachers or other adults**.

Results were overwhelmingly positive, with 95% of teachers indicating the assembly was above average or exceeded expectations. One hundred percent of the teachers agreed or strongly agreed the assembly format was an effective way to teach children about oral health.
